OPPAC Updates (Sophie Hollis in Staci Wilson's absence)

- The committee prepared for the upcoming annual conference
 - In-person registration is much higher than anticipated (200 vs. the expected 120).

- OPPAC members will help with pre-conference events, feedback sessions, and creating a conference summary webpage similar to last year.
- The committee brainstormed projects and themes for NC LIVE to focus on in the coming year.

RAC Updates (Rishara Finsel)

- The resource value survey is available now through the end of May.
 - The committee will also gather feedback with in-person sessions, including the sessions at the Annual Conference.
 - In tandem, the RAC will be looking at cost per use (in general and by COI), look at accessibility and use, and overlay that with community input.

CETAC Updates (Angel Truesdale)

- Significant increase (over 500%) in tutorial use since migrating to the new platform.
- Increased focus on resource training in response to platform updates.
- Travel budgets are being cut, so there's an increased reliance on online learning opportunities.
- Two in-person workshops are being planned.
- NC LIVE is working with NC IDEA on the Libraries for Entrepreneurial Advancement Fellowship (LEAF).

OSAC & Website Updates (Jake Vaccaro)

- OSAC will meet in person for the first time in 5 years in July 2025.
- The committee is helping with the usage statistics portal update.
- The committee talked about AI in collections and NC LIVE's role
